



Regulation on the Acquisition and Use of Gift Vouchers

MAR Shopping Matosinhos

1. The MAR Shopping Matosinhos Gift Vouchers, worth EUR 50.00, EUR 20.00, EUR 10.00 or EUR 5.00, can be purchased at MAR Shopping Matosinhos. The values of the Gift Vouchers are limited to the stock available at the time of purchase.
2. Gift Vouchers can be exchanged for products or services, with a value equal to or greater than the nominal value of the Gift Voucher or the sum of the Gift Vouchers, in any of the Shops adherent to this programme. The list of Adherent Shops can be consulted at www.marshopping.com or at the Information Desk of MAR Shopping Matosinhos. The list present on the site is the most updated, which may be changed at any time, according to the adherence and/or termination of the Shops.
3. Term of validity
 - 3.1 The term of validity for the use of the Gift Voucher as a form of payment is indicated on the back of the Gift Voucher. Ingka Centres Portugal, S.A., owner of MAR Shopping Matosinhos, and/or its Tenants are not responsible for the Gift Vouchers whose term of validity has expired, being entitled not to accept any exchange or refund of the value corresponding to the Gift Vouchers.
 - 3.2 All the identification elements included in the Gift Voucher must be in perfect conditions of legibility. Therefore any Gift Voucher adulterated or with erasures in the dates will not be accepted for purchases at MAR Shopping Matosinhos by its Shopkeepers and/or by Ingka Centres Portugal, S.A.. The date will be printed only once and must be perfectly legible without allowing any ambiguity in its reading, in which case the use of the Gift Voucher will be refused.
4. Under any circumstances can the gift voucher be converted into cash. Gift Voucher holders may use their Gift Voucher at a single time to purchase one or more products or services of their interest in a single Adherent Shop of their choice. Consumers holding several Gift Vouchers are not obliged to use them all in the same Adherent Shop.
5. Should the total price of the chosen product(s) or service(s) be higher than the face value of the Gift Voucher, the difference in value, i.e. the difference between the total price of the chosen product(s) or service(s) and the face value of the Gift Voucher shall be paid by the Gift Voucher holder using any other means of payment admissible in the respective Adherent Shop.
6. If the price of the product(s) or service(s) is lower than the face value of the Gift Voucher, the Shopkeepers of MAR Shopping Matosinhos and/or Ingka Centres Portugal, S.A. will not refund the difference in any form, nor will they issue a new Gift Voucher corresponding to the difference.
7. The Gift Voucher may be used for any purchase (save for any exception duly and clearly announced in the respective Adherent Shop), including promotions, and is considered a cash payment method.
8. The Shopkeepers of MAR Shopping Matosinhos and/or Ingka Centres Portugal, S.A. are not responsible, under any circumstances, for the loss, theft or misplacement of Gift Vouchers.
9. The Shopkeepers of MAR Shopping Matosinhos and/or Ingka Centres Portugal, S.A. reserve the right to suspend or terminate the sale of Gift Vouchers at any time, respecting, however, the term of validity for the use of Gift Vouchers already purchased.



10. The Shopkeepers of MAR Shopping Matosinhos and/or Ingka Centres Portugal, S.A. reserve the right to, at any time, and whenever deemed necessary or convenient, partially or totally change the present Regulations.
11. MAR Shopping Matosinhos Gift Vouchers may be purchased in cash (immediate withdrawal of the Gift Vouchers), cheque made payable to "Ingka Centres Portugal, S.A." (collection of the Gift-Vouchers after validation of payment).
12. Under the law, there are the following limits to cash payments:
 - (a) Residents in Portugal are forbidden from paying or receiving cash amounts of EUR 3,000 or more (or its equivalent in foreign currency).
 - (b) Payments of EUR 1,000 or more (or its equivalent in foreign currency), made by IRC taxpayers, as well as by individuals who have or should have organized accounting, should be made through a payment method that allows the identification of the respective recipient, namely bank transfer, nominative cheque or direct debit.
 - (c) For individuals who are not resident in Portugal, the limit for payments made in cash is EUR 10,000 (or its equivalent in foreign currency), provided that they do not act as business people or traders.
 - (d) For the purpose of calculating the referred limits, all payments associated with the sale of goods or provision of services shall be considered in an aggregated manner, even if they do not exceed the applicable limit if considered in a fractioned manner.

Therefore, should the above limits apply or be exceeded, the respective payment in cash will not be accepted.
